TIP: If using lightweight interfacing, use anything heavier than the pieces of interfacing. This means that the pieces will be fused, as with the pieces of interfacing.



For lightweight fabric, we recommend block fusing this piece. For heavier fabric, we recommend piece fusing to minimise bulk. Use the **STANDARD BUTTON PLACKET TEMPLATE** as a pattern piece and cut two pieces. Position the fusing between the notches indicated. The top part of the placket visible on the front of the shirt will be the section that has the buttonholes.

GRAINLINE

Please note: you will need one **STANDARD BUTTON PLACKET [8]** and one **CONCEALED BUTTON PLACKET [9]** to create the finished placket.

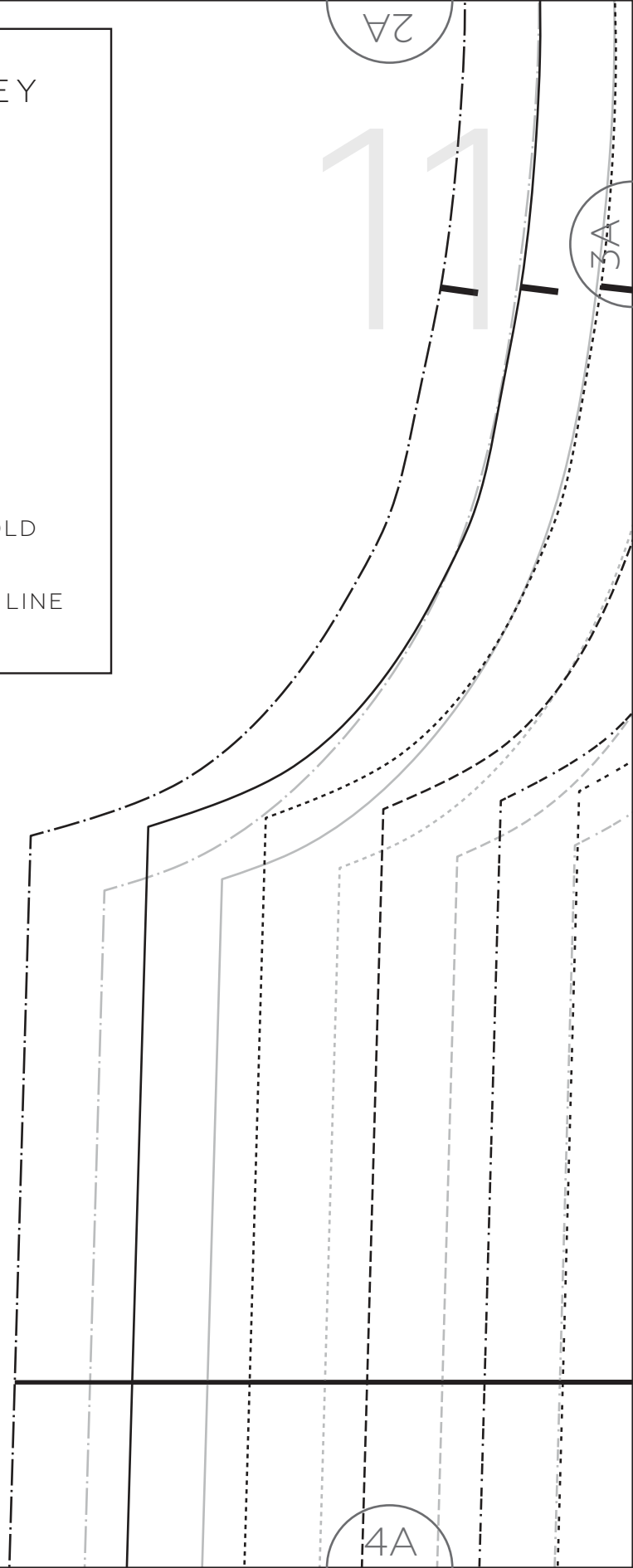


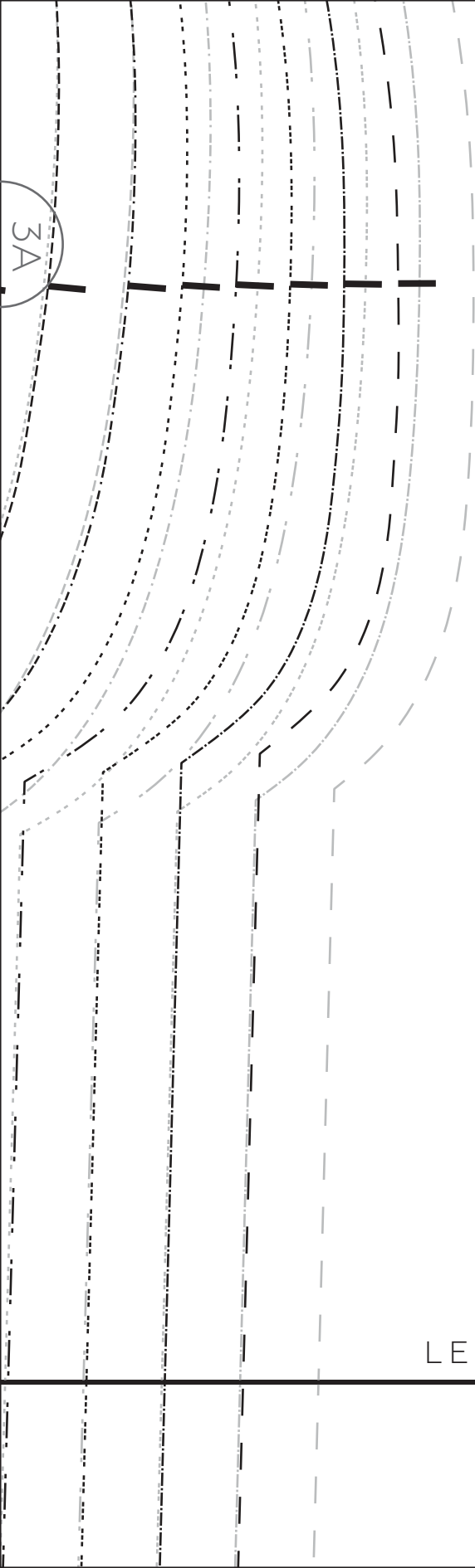
